

Rolling roadblocks on eastbound State Road (S.R.) 408 from Good Homes Road to Magnolia Avenue are scheduled between 12 a.m. and 6 a.m. on February 10 and February 11. During the rolling roadblocks, eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, its eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramp will be reopened allowing motorists to enter and join the slow roll. The rolling roadblock and temporary closures of eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramps create a 30-minute window for crews to place bridge girders for S.R. 408 bridge near Magnolia Avenue. Multiple rolling roadblocks are scheduled to occur each night. The eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramps from I-4 will be closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. on February 9-10 and 10-11 (see detour maps on reverse side). As part of the operation, motorists should expect single lane closures on eastbound and westbound S.R. 408 beginning as early as 9 p.m. on February 9 and February 10. Public safety vehicles are permitted to skip past the rolling roadblock to respond to an emergency call.

Rolling roadblocks on eastbound State Road (S.R.) 408 from Good Homes Road to Magnolia Avenue are scheduled between 12 a.m. and 6 a.m. on February 10 and February 11. During the rolling roadblocks, eastbound I-4 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. The eastbound and westbound S.R. 408 entrance ramps from I-4 will be closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. on February 9-10 and 10-11 in conjunction with the rolling roadblocks to accommodate construction. Motorists should expect additional lanes closed on eastbound S.R. 408 and I-4 during the traffic pacing operation.

Traveling eastbound I–4 to eastbound S.R. 408:

- Exit I-4 on the right to South Street (Exit 82B)
- Turn right onto South Street
- Turn right onto Orange Avenue
- Turn left onto Anderson Street
- Follow signs to eastbound S.R. 408 on-ramp

Traveling westbound westbound I-4 to eastbound S.R. 408:

- Exit I-4 on the right to Anderson Street (Exit 82B)
- Follow signs to eastbound S.R. 408 on-ramp

Traveling on westbound I-4 to westbound S.R. 408:

- Use Exit 82B to Anderson Street
- At end of ramp, turn onto Anderson Street
- Turn right onto Division Avenue
- Turn left onto South Street
- Turn left onto Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441-17/92)
- Follow signs to westbound S.R. 408 on-ramp



Traveling on eastbound I-4 to westbound S.R. 408:

- Use Exit 80B to northbound Orange Blossom Trail (U.S. 441-17/92)
- Follow signs to westbound S.R. 408 on-ramp

Closure subject to change. Construction progress, roadway conditions and weather may require schedule adjustments.
