WB I-4 BETWEEN MAITLAND BOULEVARD AND LEE ROAD SHIFTING TO TEMPORARY ALIGNMENT

WESTBOUND INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) BETWEEN LEE ROAD (STATE ROAD [S.R.] 423) AND MAITLAND BOULEVARD (S.R. 414) IS SHIFTING TO A TEMPORARY ALIGNMENT AS SOON AS MARCH 14

All lanes of westbound I-4 between Lee Road and Maitland Boulevard are shifting to a temporary alignment as soon as March 14 in preparation for construction of new westbound I-4 travel lanes. For approximately one mile, all westbound I-4 travel lanes will be shifted to the old eastbound I-4 travel lanes, which were themselves shifted to the new, permanent lanes in December 2017. The westbound I-4 exit ramp to Lee Road (Exit 88) also will shift about one-tenth of a mile sooner. The exit lane leading to the exit ramp will be maintained.

Motorists should be aware that modifications or extensions to this schedule may become necessary due to weather delays or other unforeseen conditions. Motorists are advised to maintain a safe speed when driving in this vicinity through the work zone.
