

EASTBOUND I-4 ROLLING ROADBLOCKS FROM KIRKMAN ROAD TO KALEY AVENUE

Rolling roadblocks on eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Kirkman Road (State Road [S.R.] 435) to just beyond Kaley Avenue are scheduled between 12 a.m. and 5 a.m. on October 27. During the rolling roadblocks, eastbound I-4 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, its eastbound I-4 entrance ramp will be reopened allowing motorists to enter and join the slow roll. One rolling roadblock and temporary closures of eastbound I-4 entrance ramps create a 30-minute window for crews to remove a portion of the outof-service pedestrian bridge extending over eastbound I-4 between Indiana Street and Grand Street. Public safety vehicles are permitted to skip past the rolling roadblock to respond to an emergency call.
