


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## TRAFFIC SHIFT ON WB MAITLAND BOULEVARD **RELOCATES WB I-4 ON-RAMP**

NEXT PHASE OF CONSTRUCTION OPENS PERMANENT ENTRANCE RAMP TO WESTBOUND I-4



On the night of Thursday, October 12, the next phase of construction at the Maitland Boulevard (State Road 414) and Interstate 4 (I-4) relocates the westbound I-4 entrance ramp to its permanent location on the newly constructed westbound Maitland Boulevard elevated lanes. The shift will eliminate the fork on westbound Maitland Boulevard near Hope Road that required motorists to choose the left lane for westbound I-4, or the right two lanes to continue on westbound Maitland Boulevard, eastbound I-4 entrance ramp or Hope Road. The newly constructed lanes of westbound Maitland Boulevard were opened on September 24. The traffic shift changed traffic patterns at the I-4 interchange and intersections of Hope Road, Lake Destiny Road, Keller Road and Maitland Summit Boulevard. - All motorists heading westbound on Maitland Blvd. from Maitland Ave. travel in the same direction to continue on WB Maitland Blvd., or enter Hope Road, EB I-4 or WB I-4. (This shift will eliminate the split of WB Maitland Blvd.)
- Traffic signal at WB Maitland Blvd. and Hope Rd. is eliminated.
- Traffic signal at EB Maitland Blvd. to EB I-4 on-ramp is eliminated.
- Two new left-turn lanes on WB Maitland Blvd. to WB I-4 on-ramp.
- Temporary traffic signal remains in operation to allow traffic entering WB I-4 on-ramp to cross eastbound Maitland Blvd.



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
