ATTENTION NORTHBOUND KIRKMAN ROAD MOTORISTS

A TRAFFIC SHIFT IS SCHEDULED FOR NORTHBOUND
KIRKMAN ROAD (STATE ROAD 435) OVER INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) IN EARLY NOVEMBER

This long-term traffic pattern of approximately a quarter-mile in length will relocate the northbound lanes to a newly constructed bridge just south of the existing bridge. The new traffic pattern is necessary for the reconstruction of Kirkman Road interchange. In addition to this traffic shift on the northbound Kirkman Road bridge, the eastbound I-4 exit ramp (Exit 75B) to northbound Kirkman Road will be moving to the west. Motorists will need to exit sooner on I-4 for this new temporary ramp. Exact date of the traffic shift will be available on i4Ultimate.com/alertsmap.

Motorists should be aware that modifications or extensions to this schedule may become necessary due to weather delays or other unforeseen conditions. Motorists are advised to maintain a safe speed when driving in this vicinity through the work zone.
