## WESTBOUND I-4 ACCESS AT PRINCETON STREET TEMPORARILY CLOSING AT NIGHT

THE WESTBOUND I-4 ENTRANCE AND EXIT RAMPS AT PRINCETON STREET ARE CLOSING NIGHTLY FOR THREE WEEKS AS SOON AS LATE APRIL.

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing at night the westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) entrance and exit ramps at Princeton Street for about three weeks. The ramp closures may occur each night from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. The closures are necessary for roadway wall construction. Princeton Street ramps will be not be closed when the Ivanhoe Boulevard ramps are closed. Exact dates of the closures will be available on i4Ultimate.com/alertsmap.

### Traveling to westbound I-4 from Princeton Street:


- Travel south on Orange Avenue
- Slight right onto Ivanhoe Boulevard
- Turn right onto Magnolia Avenue
- Turn left onto westbound I-4 entrance ramp

### Traveling westbound I-4 to Princeton Street:

- Take westbound I-4 Exit 84B to Ivanhoe Boulevard
- Turn right onto Ivanhoe Boulevard
- Turn left to continue on Ivanhoe Boulevard/ Orange Avenue
- · Continue to Princeton Street

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
