NEW HAMPSHIRE STREET UNDER I-4 CLOSING FEBRUARY 26-MARCH 1

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing New Hampshire Street under Interstate 4 (I-4) from midnight on Tuesday, February 26 through 5 a.m. on Friday, March 1. This closure is necessary for various bridge construction activities including pile driving. Pile driving is limited to daytime hours from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
