EB I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATIONS SCHEDULED FEBRUARY 12

A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur between midnight and 5 a.m. the morning of Wednesday, February 12, on eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from Princeton Street to E.E. Williamson Road. During the operation, eastbound I-4 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, the eastbound entrance ramp will be reopened to allow motorists to enter I-4 and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary ramp closures of eastbound I-4 entrance ramps create a 30-minute window for crews to relocate utilities. Traffic pacing operations also are occurring on westbound I-4 during the same time. Please see reverse for details.
