Traffic pacing operations on eastbound State Road (S.R.) 408 from Good Homes Road to Interstate 4 (I-4) are scheduled between 12 a.m. and 5 a.m. on November 9. During the traffic pacing operations, eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, its eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramp will be reopened allowing motorists to enter and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operations and temporary closures of eastbound S.R. 408 entrance ramps create a 30-minute window for crews to place bridge girders for S.R. 408 flyover ramps at I-4. Multiple traffic pacing operations are scheduled to occur. As part of the operation, motorists should expect lane closures on eastbound and westbound S.R. 408 beginning as early as 9 p.m. on November 8. Public safety vehicles are permitted to skip past the rolling roadblock to respond to an emergency call.
