

## **BUILDING A BETTER 1-4**

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# CONSTRUCTION OF PINE BAY SOUND BARRIER BEGINNING IN JANUARY

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is constructing a ground-mounted sound barrier at the location shown below. To construct the sound barrier, crews will drill holes in the ground and set posts. Precast concrete panels will then be installed between the posts. This build method does not require pile driving, which typically creates noise and vibration to nearby properties.

Beginning as soon as the week of January 6, crews will begin construction on the wall along Interstate 4 (I-4). Completion of the sound barrier could take about three months. The area in which the barrier will be built has already been cleared of vegetation.

Installing a barrier east of the eastbound I-4 travel lanes between E.E. Williamson Road and Lake Mary Boulevard will help block the direct travel of sound waves to nearby residences. FDOT will be adding an eastbound I-4 auxiliary lane from the I-4 Ultimate project to west of Lake Mary Boulevard. 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
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### IMPROVEMENTS TO INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) IN SEMINOLE COUNTY

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is conducting improvement projects along I-4 in Seminole County that will help keep traffic flowing more smoothly and safely. The projects include adding an auxiliary lane and resurfacing eastbound I-4 from the I-4 Ultimate project to west of Lake Mary Boulevard (FPID: 439682-3) and reconstructing the E.E. Williamson Road overpass (FPID: 439682-4). It also includes resurfacing both directions of I-4 from west of Lake Mary Boulevard to County Road 46A and State Road 46 to the Volusia County line (FPIDs: 439682-1, -2, -5).

- These projects will help accommodate traffic from the eastbound I-4 Ultimate Express Lanes as well as extend the life of the existing pavement on I-4.
- Construction on eastbound
   I-4 began in August 2019.
   Construction on westbound I-4 is scheduled to begin in mid 2020.
- During construction, lane closures on I-4 will be limited to overnight hours between 8 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.





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
