

BUILDING A BETTER I-4

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WB I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION **SCHEDULED BETWEEN** NORTH OF E.E. WILLIAMSON ROAD AND WYMORE ROAD

A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur on westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from north of E.E. Williamson Road to Wymore Road between midnight and 5 a.m. on Wednesday, February 17.

During the activity, westbound I-4 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation and traffic will slow to 10 mph. As the pace car passes an interchange, the westbound entrance ramp will be reopened to allow motorists to enter I-4 and join the slow roll.

The traffic pacing operation and the temporary closures of westbound I-4 entrance ramps will create a 30-minute window for crews to install overhead signs.
