EB I-4 TRAFFIC PACING OPERATION SCHEDULED BETWEEN STATE ROAD 535 AND UNIVERSAL BOULEVARD

A traffic pacing operation is scheduled to occur between midnight and 5 a.m. the morning of Friday, August 16, on eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) from the Kissimmee-Vineland Road (State Road 535) to Universal Boulevard. During the operation, eastbound I-4 entrance ramps will be temporarily blocked by law enforcement officers to ensure no vehicles jump ahead of the traffic pacing operation. As the pace car passes an interchange, the eastbound entrance ramp will be reopened to allow motorists to enter I-4 and join the slow roll. The traffic pacing operation and temporary ramp closures of eastbound I-4 entrance ramps create a 30-minute window for crews to move equipment and install overhead signs.
