
## **EASTBOUND I-4 EXIT RAMP TO PRINCETON STREET MOVING 2 MILES SOONER**

NEW TEMPORARY COLLECTOR-DISTRIBUTOR ROAD ADJACENT TO EASTBOUND I-4 **OPENING BETWEEN COLONIAL DRIVE AND PRINCETON STREET** 

As soon as the morning of September 22, motorists on eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) who wish to exit to Princeton Street (Exit 85) will be required to do so nearly 2 miles sooner. The new temporary configuration will shift Exit 85 on eastbound I-4 closer to Colonial Drive (State Road 50). The Exit 85 ramp will merge with the eastbound I-4 entrance ramp from Colonial Drive/Garland Avenue. Motorists entering eastbound I-4 will notice their entrance point onto the eastbound I-4 mainline places them just above New Hampshire Street. The purpose of this temporary configuration is to create more room to construct permanent eastbound I-4 lanes and accommodate future traffic shifts.

## **PROJECT INFO**

The \$2.3 billion I-4 Ultimate project is reconstructing 21 miles of interstate from west of Kirkman Road to east of State Road 434 in Longwood.
