EASTBOUND I-4 EXIT RAMP TO NORTHBOUND KIRKMAN ROAD SHIFTING TO TEMPORARY LOCATION

EASTBOUND INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) EXIT RAMP TO NORTHBOUND KIRKMAN ROAD (STATE ROAD 435) IS TEMPORARILY MOVING TO GRAND NATIONAL DRIVE AND CHANGING TO A LEFT EXIT

The eastbound I-4 exit ramp to northbound Kirkman Road (Exit 75B) is closing until next year beginning at 10 p.m. Wednesday, October 17, to construct a new exit ramp. During construction of the new ramp, traffic heading from eastbound I-4 to northbound Kirkman Road will use a temporary exit ramp exiting from the left side of eastbound I-4 to Grand National Drive. A new traffic signal on Grand National Drive will control traffic movements from the temporary eastbound I-4 exit. When the I-4 Ultimate project is completed, the ramps at Grand National Drive will support I-4 Express Lanes. The newly constructed eastbound I-4 exit ramp to northbound Kirkman Road is scheduled to reopen in summer 2019.
