EB I-4 RAMP SYSTEM OVER PRINCETON STREET CLOSING AT NIGHT

PORTION OF EASTBOUND INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) RAMP SYSTEM ADJACENT TO INTERSTATE MAINLINE DETOURING AT PRINCETON STREET

The Florida Department of Transportation is temporarily closing a portion of the eastbound I-4 temporary ramp system over Princeton Street for three nights. The closures begin at midnight and conclude by 5 a.m. on May 7, 8 and 9. The detour route will make motorists exit to Princeton Street and crossover to the entrance ramp to re-enter the CD road system. Princeton Street under I-4 will also be closing at 10 p.m. on May 6-13 and reopening by 5 a.m. the following mornings. Law enforcement will be present to monitor the traffic signals and facilitate the flow of traffic at the interchange. These closures are necessary to safely place girders over Princeton Street.

Traveling westbound on Princeton St.:

- Turn right on Orange Avenue
- Turn right on Colonial Drive
- Turn right on Edgewater Drive
- Continue onto Princeton Street

Traveling eastbound on Princeton St.:


- Turn onto Edgewater Drive
- Turn left onto Colonial Drive
- Turn left onto Magnolia Avenue
- Continue onto Princeton Street

Traveling eastbound I-4 ramp system:

- Take Exit 85 to Princeton Street
- Cross over Princeton Street and re-enter the ramp system
